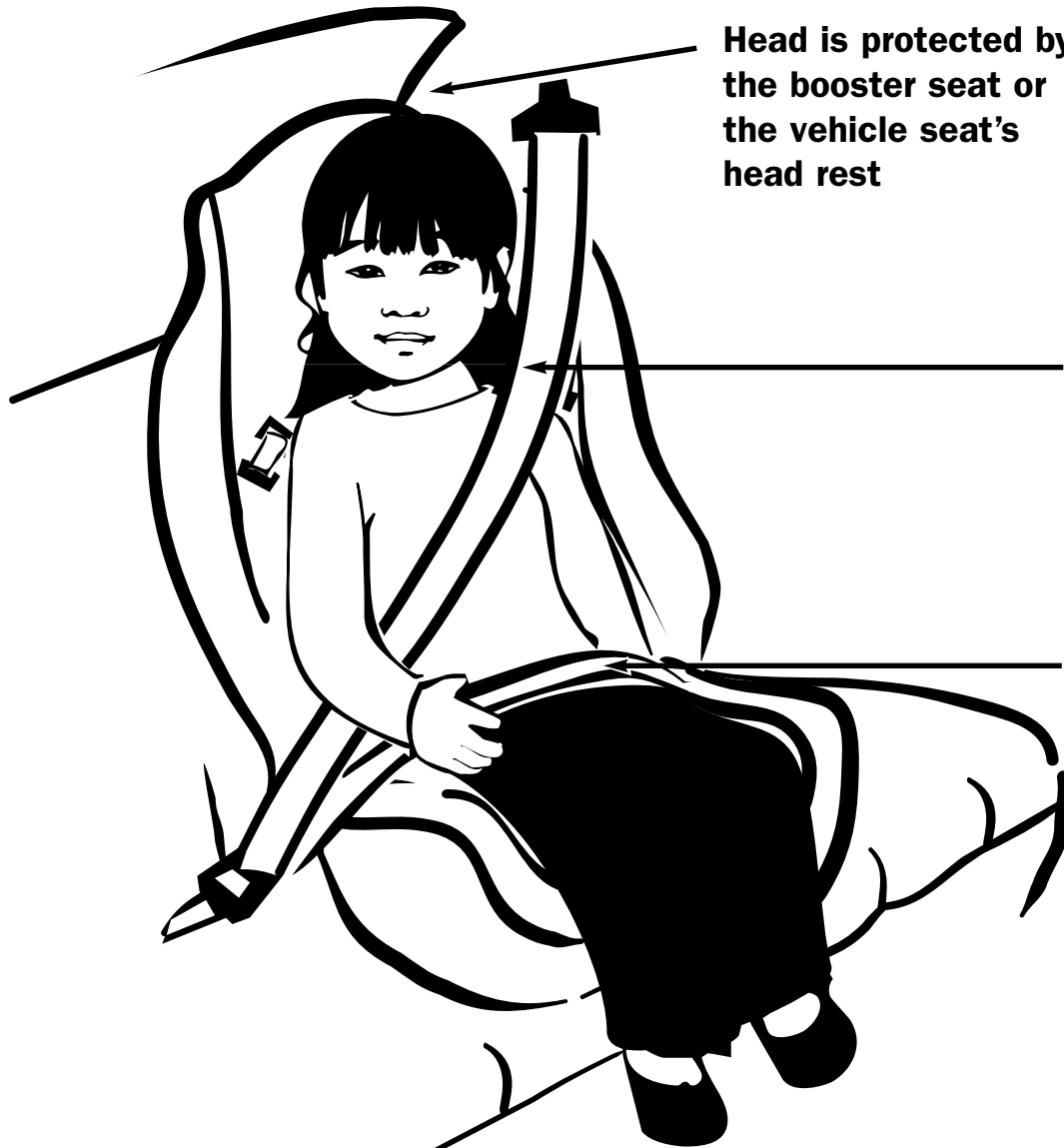


# booster safety seats

Read your vehicle  
and booster seat  
instructions.

From 40 pounds (18 kilograms) to 80 pounds  
(36 kilograms) or 8 years of age.

Once children are too big for a forward-facing safety seat, they need a booster seat. A booster seat helps the seat belt fit a child's body safely.



Head is protected by  
the booster seat or  
the vehicle seat's  
head rest

Shoulder  
strap fits  
between the  
neck and  
shoulder

Lap belt fits  
low over the  
hips
