

# Graduate Research Assistantship

## Department of Family Medicine – Research Program

Clinical Faculty in the Department of Family Medicine are seeking a Graduate Research Assistant (GRA) to assist with studies in research synthesis.

The GRA will work with an interdisciplinary team performing syntheses of studies which examine the interdisciplinary team in primary care. We have already preformed a scoping review of the available literature which was funded by CIHR. Some aspects of the team have been sufficiently examined to permit a systematic review of the findings while others have not. Our team is in the process of submitting an application to CIHR for funding of such a review as well as waiting funding for a study of teams in primary care.

### Ideal Candidate will:

- Be a Masters or PhD student in the health or social sciences or education
- Have a demonstrated interest in research
- Be experienced in database searching
- Have excellent organisational and writing skills
- Possess effective communications skills
- Be prepared to work with minimal supervision, but also contribute to the research team process

### Details of Appointment

This is a **12 hour per week** Graduate Research Assistantship during the winter term. In accordance with the current GSA/Boards of Governors Agreement, the remuneration will be \$4,818.75 for Masters and \$5,035.50 for PhD students for three months (February - April, 2008).
