

## Relief Supported Housing Coordinators

The Canadian Mental Health Association in Calgary requires several casual relief staff for our Supported Housing program. These positions provide supportive counseling, community resource information, living skills and leisure assistance to adults with a mental illness living in community group homes and half-way houses.

Candidates should have a good understanding of mental illness, strong teaching and supportive counseling skills, and good advocacy and communication skills. The individual will be required to work independently as well as in a team environment. The ability to work shift work is required.

A diploma or degree in a helping profession, experience working with persons with a mental illness and previous residential experience are assets. Experience in correctional services is also an asset.
